DETAIL ITINERARY :

Day 01: Amritsar

Arrive Amritsar Airport / Railway station & transfer to Hotel, Hotel check in & freshen up. After noon, time leave to [Wagah Border](#) for enjoy Flag Retreat Ceremony. In Evening return back and visit Golden temple, local Market for shopping etc. **Over Night** stay at **Amritsar Hotel**.

{Wagah border is 30 km far from Amritsar on Indo -Pak Border. Everyday at sunset Flag Retreat Ceremony is done by both Countries' Soldiers with march-past in perfect drill. Every Indian is filled with pride and enthusiasm on witnessing the Beating Retreat Ceremony . This ceremony includes the closing of the international gates and lowering the flags of both countries.}

{AMRITSAR : Home of the glorious Golden Temple, is the iconic city of Amritsar. It was founded in the 16th century. Its name is a derivative of the Amrit Sarovar (pool of nectar) amidst which stands the Golden Temple, the most sacred of Sikh shrines. It's ancient legends, historical monuments, places of worship, old bazaars, theatre traditions and colorful festivals all serve as a window to its robust past. Amritsar also commends importance with the memorial of Jallianwala Bagh & Wagah Border for Beating Retreat Ceremony}

Day 02: Amritsar - Dalhousie (200km/4-5Hsr)

Morning after breakfast, Hotel check out & visit Golden Temple & Jaliyowala Bagh, Later depart for Dalhousie. Arrive Dalhousie, hotel check in & freshen up in evening kept free for leisure / walk at mall road. **Over Night** Stay at **Dalhousie Hotel**.

{DALHOUSIE: The "Little Switzerland of India" Dalhousie is a beautiful hill station, replete with misty valleys, green landscapes and with grand views of Dauladhar range. It's a popular hill station that was founded by Lord Dalhousie in 1850 as a summer retreat. The Scottish and Victorian architecture reminds one of its colonial heritage, rich architecture and beautiful churches.}

Day 03: Dalhousie - Khaziar

After Breakfast leave for half day Khaziar Trip (Called Mini Switzerland) Visit [Khaziar Valley](#), [Temple](#), enjoy Horse ride & Enroute visit, [Dain Kund Peak](#) etc. After noon return back to Dalhousie & visit local sightseeing i.e. [PanchPula](#), [Satdhara](#), [subhash Baoli](#), [St John's Church](#), [Shubash Chowk](#), [Gandhi Chowk](#) etc. **Over Night** stay at **Dalhousie Hotel**.

{Khaziar :- Often referred to as 'Mini-Switzerland of India', Khaziar is a small town near Dalhousie (25km -1 ½ Hrs) Located at an altitude of 6,500 feet. Khaziar is known for its nine-hole golf-course which is nestled in the midst of lush greenery and a breathtaking landscape. It is a small plateau which also has a small lake which is one of the most favored tourist spots in this town. With a small town vibe, fresh mountain air and picturesque landscapes encompassing dense deodar forests, verdant meadows and snow-laden mountains, it is an adventurer and nature lover's playground.}

Day 04 : Dalhousie - Dharmshala

Morning after breakfast, Hotel check out & drive to Dharamshala (160 Kms / 4-5 Hrs). After Noon arrive Dharmshala, hotel check in. After Freshen up, visit local Sightseeing i.e. [Cricket Stadium](#), [Dal Lake](#), [War Memorial](#), [Temple](#) etc, rest day free for leisure. **Over Night** stay at **Dharamshala Hotel**.

{DHARMSHALA : Surrounded by cedar forests on the edge of the Himalayas, Dharmshala the hillside city is home to the Dalai Lama and the Tibetan government-in-exile. Situated at an average altitude of 1,475 meters above sea level, it's lies on the scenic stretch of land of Kangra Valley making tourists spellbound for its spectacular beauty. It's Often cited as the "Little Lhasa of India".} It is separated as lower (it self Dharmshala) and upper divisions (Mc'leodganj)- is a spiritual center for Tibetan Buddhism}

Day 05 : Dharamshala Departure

After breakfast, hotel check out & visit [Mc' leodganj](#), [St John's Church](#), [Tibet Monastery](#), [Bhagsunath Temple](#), [Water fall](#) etc. later proceed for Pathankot (90km / 3-4Hrs) for catch your return train / Flight for your onward / return Journey . **"Tour Ends With Sweet Memories of a Wonderful Holiday."**
