**11N/12D**

**Day 01: Ranthambore National Park**

On arrival at Sawai Madhopur Railway Station, transfer to hotel. Check-in to hotel, rest day free for leisure / Personal Activities. After noon move for Jungle Safari in [Ranthambore Tiger Reserve National Park](#) by Jeep / Canter (*At your own cost*). **Over Night** stay at **Ranthambore Hotel**.

*{Ranthambore National park- the most renowned national park, Surrounded by Vindhya & Aravalis Hills, valley of the Chambal river, ranges is spreads over an area of 392 sq.km of thick forest punctuated with pleasant waterfalls. Ranthambore is a wildlife-lover's paradise, home to the Royal Bengal Tigers, other animals found here include Chinkara, Sambhar, Cheetal and over 300 species of birds.}*

**Day 02: Ranthambore- Chittorgarh (300Km/6Hrs)**

Early Morning, after breakfast check out from hotel and visit [Ranthambore Fort & Ganesh Temple](#). Later drive to Chittorgarh. In Evening arrive Chittorgarh, Hotel check in. **Over Night** stay at **Chittorgarh Hotel**.

*{Chittorgarh is the epitome of Rajput pride, romance and spirit. It reverberates with history of heroism and sacrifice, which is evident as it echoes with the tales sung by the Bards of Rajasthan. The main reason for visiting Chittorgarh is its massive hilltop fort, which is a depiction of Rajput culture and values. The fort stands on a 240-hectares site on a 180m high hill that rises rapidly from the plains below.}*

**Day 03: Chittorgarh - Udaipur (130Km / 2-3 Hrs) v**

Early Morning, after breakfast check out from hotel, Visit in [Chittorgarh fort, Temple -Palace - garden - Kund - Vijay Stambh](#) etc. later drive to Udaipur (3Hrs), enroute visit [Sawariya Ji temple](#) Evening arrive Udaipur, Hotel check in. **Over Night** stay at **Udaipur Hotel**.

**Day 04: Udaipur Sight Seeing**

After breakfast start for Udaipur city tour Visit [City Palace](#) - The largest palace complex of Rajasthan, [Jagdish Temple](#) - built by Maharana Jagat Singh and is dedicated to Lord Vishnu, [Rope Way & Later visit Seheliyon-KI-Bari](#) - Queen's resort for their friends, [Maharana Pratap Memorial](#), [Fateh Sagar](#) (Enjoy Boating & take a photo stop at [Nehru Garden](#)) [Sukhadia Circle \(Drive Pass\)](#), **Over Night** stay at **Udaipur Hotel**.

*{Udaipur Known as the "City of Lakes" & "Venice of the East" formerly the capital of the Mewar Kingdom, is the crown jewel of the state of Rajasthan. Udaipur is surrounded by the lush green Aravali Hills & series of four water lakes. It's founded by Maharaja Udai Singh II in 1552. The Palaces, grand Gardens, Lakes, Museums and cultural shows present a glimpse of its rich past.}*

**Day 05: Udaipur - Mount Abu (200Km / 3-4 hrs) via Rankpur**

Morning, after breakfast Hotel check out & drive to Mt. Abu, Enroute visit [Ranakpur Jain Chaumukha Temple](#) built in 1439. This marble temple has 29 halls supported by 1444 pillars. On arrival Mt. Abu, check-in to your hotel. Free for personal activities, walk at [Mall Road](#) & enjoy in [Nakki Lake](#), later In the Evening enjoy the Sunset from [Sunset View Point](#) in Mt. Abu. **Over Night** stay at **Mt. Abu Hotel**

**Day 06: Mount Abu Local Sight Seeing**

After breakfast start for Mt. Abu city tour visiting [Prajapita Brahmakumari](#), [Adhar Devi Temple](#), [Achalgarh](#), [Guru Sikhar](#), [Dilwara Jain Temple](#), [Honeymoon Point](#), [Art Gallery & Nakki Lake](#) where you can enjoy boat ride in at your own cost. **Over Night** stay at **Mt. Abu Hotel**.

*{Mount Abu Or Arbuda Mountain is the only Hill station in Rajasthan and often referred to as "an Oasis in the Desert". It's situated 1220mtrs above sea level of the Aravali Hills, It's surrounded by Lake - lush green Forest - Water Fall - Temples (famous for Delwara Jain Temple, build between 11-13<sup>th</sup> centuries AD, famous for white marble architecturally - interiors - designs)}*

**Day 07: Mount Abu - Jaisalmer (440Km / 8-9 hrs)**

Early Morning after breakfast check out from hotel and drive to Jaisalmer, in evening arrive Jaisalmer, check-in to hotel. Later Later Hotel check in. In evening visit local Market for shopping etc. **Over Night** stay at **Jaisalmer Hotel**.

*{Jaisalmer, "the Golden City", is known for its Fort Rajwada, yellow sandstone Structures, dusky Landscape , romantic Sand Dunes, ravishing Havelis, splendid Temples, graceful with Lakes and vibrant Bazaars. The city was founded in 12th century by Ruler Rawla Jaisal.}*

#### **Day 08: Jaisalmer Sight Seeing & Camp**

After breakfast, Hotel check out visit the [Jaisalmer Fort](#) which is made by unique Golden Lime stone, that's why it's known as Golden Fort or Sonar Qila. After that, visit [Jain Temple](#), [Patwon-ki-haveli](#), [War Museum & Gadisar Lake](#) etc. After that drive to Sum Desert (40Km /1Hr), Arrive [Desert Camp city](#), check in your Dlx Swiss tent, later enjoy camel ride on Sam Sand Dunes & you can experience the spectacular view of Sunset in Thar desert & later enjoy Folk dance Program with Traditional Dinner. **Over Night** stay at **Jaisalmer Camp**.

#### **Day 09: Jaisalmer - Jodhpur (290Km /5hrs)**

After breakfast checkout from Desert Camp and drive to Jodhpur, On arrival check-in to your hotel. Later visit local city tour Covering [Mehrangarh Fort](#)- situated on a low sandstone hill, with in the fort visit Moti Mahal and Phool Mahal. Also visit [Jaswant Thada](#) - an imposing marble cenotaph built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II around 1899 etc. and [Mandore Garden](#) & local market for shopping etc. **Over Night** stay at **Jodhpur Hotel**.

*{Jodhpur, formerly known as Marwar it's also known as the "The Blue City", "Sun City "and "Gateway to Thar". The city was founded in 1459 A.D by the Rathore rulers. Jodhpur is famous for its Mehrangarh fort, Palace, Temples, Sweets – Snacks and Blue Houses, as most of the architecture – forts, palaces, temples, havelis and even houses are built in vivid shades of blue in the old cit.}*

#### **Day 10: Jodhpur - Jaipur via Pushkar -Ajmer (330km/ 5-6Hrs)**

After breakfast check out from hotel & visit [Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum..](#) Later drive, to Jaipur. Enroute visit Ajmer -Pushkar ([Dargah -e- Sharif](#), [Brahma Temple](#), [Sarovar etc.](#)), after visit, continue drive to Jaipur (135Km / 3Hrs). In Evening, arrive Jaipur, check in your hotel. **Over Night** stay at **Jaipur Hotel**.

*{It's nestled in Aravali hills, Ajmer city is known for its rich heritage, culture, and significant history, famous for the Ajmer Dargah Sharif, and near by Pushkar, Called Tirtha- raj, is one of the olden town in India, famous for Brahma Temple – Pushkar lake, it's the ultimate Hindu pilgrimage.}*

#### **Day 11: Jaipur**

Morning after B/fast, You can begin with a visit to the [Amber fort](#), & [Jal Mahal](#) (Stop for Photo Shoot) later visit [City Palace](#) which is known to be the formal residence of a royal family, visit Chandra mahal – City Palace Museum which houses the private collection of Jaipur Maharajas, After Sight Seeing around the palace, visit [Jantar-Mantar](#) which is a stone observatory and the largest observatory built by Maharaja Jai Singh, also visit [Hawa Mahal](#), [Birla Temple](#) in evening enjoy Shopping in [Colorful Pink City Bazar](#) etc.. **Over Night** stay at **Jaipur Hotel**.

*{The capital city of Rajasthan, is a vibrant combination of the old and the new. It was developed as a planned city in the 1727 AD by Sawai Jai Singh II. Beautiful Palaces, Forts, Museum, Temples and colorful bazaars speak of the PINK CITY'S glorious regal past.}*

#### **Day 12: Hotel - Jaipur Railway Station /Airport**

After breakfast, free for leisure / personal activities, later check out from hotel on time and transfer to Jaipur Railway Station / Airport for your onward journey. **"Tour End With Sweet Memories of a Wonderful Holiday."**
