

JAIPUR (2N) - RANTHAMBORE (1N)

Day 01: Arrive in Jaipur

Arrival at Jaipur Railway Station / Airport, transfer to hotel. Check-in to the hotel and freshen up. Later, leave for half day local Sight Seeing around the city. You can begin with a visit to the **City Palace** which is known to be the formal residence of a royal family, visit Chandra mahal – City Palace Museum which houses the private collection of Jaipur Maharajas, After Sight Seeing around the palace, visit **Jantar-Mantar** which is a stone observatory and the largest observatory built by Maharaja Jai Singh, also visit **Hawa Mahal** & In the evening enjoy Shopping in **Colorful Pink City Bazar**. **Over Night stay at Jaipur Hotel.**

*{Jaipur : The capital city of Rajasthan, is a vibrant combination of the old and the new. It was developed as a planned city in the 1727 AD by Sawai Jai Singh II. Beautiful Palaces, Forts, Museum, Temples and colorful bazaars speak of the **PINK CITY'S** glorious regal past.}*

Day 02: Jaipur

After breakfast leave for a Sight Seeing tour around Jaipur. The first attraction which you visit today is the **Amber Fort & Palace**. Explore the glorious past of Rajasthan with a visit to these historical attractions. Later, take a photo stop at **Jal Mahal**, Later visit **Albet Hall Museum**. In the evening, visit the famous **Laxmi Narayan Mandir**. Later enjoy at Shopping mall **OR** Pink City Bazar **OR** you can take an **optional tour** to visit **Chokhi Dhani – An Ethnic Village Resort**. Late night return back to hotel. **Over Night stay at Jaipur Hotel.**

Day 03: Jaipur – Ranthambore National Park (155 Km / 3 hrs)

After breakfast transfer to Ranthambore. On arrival check-in to your hotel & freshen up & enjoy Resort amenities. After noon move for Jungle Safari in **Ranthambore Tiger Reserve National Park** by Jeep / Canter *(At your own cost)*. **Over Night stay at Ranthambore Hotel.**

{Ranthambore National park- the most renowned national park, Surrounded by Vindhyas & Aravalis Hills, valley of the Chambal river, ranges is spreads over an area of 392 sq.km of thick forest punctuated with pleasant waterfalls. Ranthambore is a wildlife-lover's paradise, home to the Royal Bengal Tigers, other animals found here include Chinkara, Sambhar, Cheetal and over 300 species of birds.}

Day 04: Ranthambore National Park – Jaipur Airport / Railway Station (155 Km / 3 hrs)

After breakfast check out from hotel, and visit **Ranthambore Fort** built in 994 A.D. atop high creek 200 meters above sea level & **Ganesh ji Temple**, later transfer to Sawai Madhopur / Jaipur Railway Station / Airport for your onward / return Journey. **“Tour End with Sweet Memories of a Wonderful Holiday.”**
