

JAIPUR (2N) - JODHPUR (1N) - UDAIPUR (2N)

5N / 6D

Day 01: Arrive in Jaipur

Arrival at Jaipur Railway Station / Airport, transfer to hotel. Check-in to the hotel and freshen up. Later, leave for half day local Sight Seeing around the city. You can begin with a visit to the [City Palace](#) which is known to be the formal residence of a royal family, visit Chandra mahal – City Palace Museum which houses the private collection of Jaipur Maharajas, After Sight Seeing around the palace, visit [Jantar-Mantar](#) which is a stone observatory and the largest observatory built by Maharaja Jai Singh, also visit [Hawa Mahal](#) & In the evening enjoy Shopping in [Colorful Pink City Bazar](#). **Over Night stay at Jaipur Hotel.**

{JAIPUR : The capital city of Rajasthan, is a vibrant combination of the old and the new. It was developed as a planned city in the 1727 AD by Sawai Jai Singh II. Beautiful Palaces, Forts, Museum, Temples and colorful bazaars speak of the PINK CITY'S glorious regal past.}

Day 02: Jaipur

After breakfast leave for a Sight Seeing tour around Jaipur. The first attraction which you visit today is the [Amber Fort & Palace](#). Explore the glorious past of Rajasthan with a visit to these historical attractions. Later, take a photo stop at [Jal Mahal](#), Later visit [Albet Hall Museum](#). In the evening, visit the famous [Laxmi Narayan Mandir](#). Later enjoy at Shopping mall **OR** Pink City Bazar **OR** you can take an **optional tour** to visit [Chokhi Dhani - An Ethnic Village Resort](#). Late night return back to hotel. **Over Night stay at Jaipur Hotel.**

Day 03: Jaipur – Jodhpur (336 Km / 6 hrs)

After breakfast drive to Jodhpur. On arrival, check-in to your hotel. Later visit local city tour Covering [Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum](#), [Mehrangarh Fort](#)- situated on a low sandstone hill, within the fort visit Moti Mahal and Phool Mahal. Also visit [Jaswant Thada](#) - an imposing marble cenotaph built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II around 1899, [Kaylana Lake and Mandore Garden](#) etc. **Over Night stay at Jodhpur Hotel.**

{JODHPUR, formerly known as Marwar it's also known as the "The Blue City", "Sun City "and "Gateway to Thar". The city was founded in 1459 A.D by the Rathore rulers. Jodhpur is famous for its Mehrangarh fort, Palace, Temples, Sweets – Snacks and Blue Houses, as most of the architecture – forts, palaces, temples, havelis and even houses are built in vivid shades of blue in the old cit.}

Day 04: Jodhpur – Udaipur (250 Km / 4 hrs) Via Rankpur Jain temple Or Nathdwara Temple

After breakfast drive to Udaipur. Enroute visit Ranakpur Chaumukha Temple built in 1439. This marble temple has 29 halls supported by 1444 pillars. On arrival, check-in to your hotel. Later visit some Sight Seeing [Seheliyon-KI-Bari](#) - Queen's resort for their friends, [Maharana Pratap Memorial](#), [Fateh Sagar](#) (Enjoy Boating & take a photo stop at [Nehru Garden](#)) [Sukhadia Circle](#) (Drive Pass), [Bhartiya Lok kala Museum](#) - a museum of folk and art, it displays a rich collection of folk dresses, ornaments, puppets, masks, dolls etc. **Over Night stay at Udaipur Hotel.**

NOTE: 2 ways going to Jodhpur, Via [Rankpur Jain Temple](#) **OR** [Nathwdara Temple](#). Enroute you can visit any 1 point

NOTE FOR NATHDWARA TEMPLE : The Darshan timing frequently changing, so before visiting the temple check it's website(www.nathdwaratemple.org) for that day timing & reach at least half an hour before the set time

Day 05: Udaipur SightSeeing

After breakfast start for Udaipur city tour Visit [City Palace](#) – The largest palace complex of Rajasthan, [Jagdish Temple](#) – built by Maharana Jagat Singh and is dedicated to Lord Vishnu & [Gulab Bagh](#), [Dudh talai](#), [Rope Way](#) & in Evening free at local market for shopping. **Over Night stay at Udaipur Hotel.**

{UDAIPUR Known as the "City of Lakes" & "Venice of the East" formerly the capital of the Mewar Kingdom, is the crown jewel of the state of Rajasthan. Udaipur is surrounded by the lush green Aravali Hills & series of four water lakes. It's founded by Maharaja Udai Singh II in 1552. The Palaces, grand Gardens, Lakes, Museums and cultural shows present a glimpse of its rich past.}

Day 06: Hotel – Udaipur Railway Station / Airport

After breakfast, free for leisure / personal activities and check out from hotel on time. Later transfer to Udaipur Or Jaipur (7-8Hrs) Railway Station / Airport for your onward / Return Journey. **"Tour Ends With Sweet Memories of a Wonderful Holiday."**
