

JAIPUR (2N) – {CHITTAURGARH} – UDAIPUR (2N) – KUMBHALGARH (1N) – {RANKPUR} – JODHPUR (1N)

6N / 7D



Day 01: Arrive in Jaipur

Arrival at Jaipur Railway Station / Airport, transfer to hotel. Check-in to the hotel and freshen up. Later, leave for half day local Sight Seeing around the city. You can begin with a visit to the **City Palace** which is known to be the formal residence of a royal family, visit Chandra mahal – City Palace Museum which houses the private collection of Jaipur Maharajas, After Sight Seeing around the palace, visit **Jantar-Mantar** which is a stone observatory and the largest observatory built by Maharaja Jai Singh, also visit **Hawa Mahal** & In the evening enjoy Shopping in **Colorful Pink City Bazar**. **Over Night stay at Jaipur Hotel.**

{Jaipur: The capital city of Rajasthan, is a vibrant combination of the old and the new. It was developed as a planned city in the 1727 AD by Sawai Jai Singh II. Beautiful Palaces, Forts, Museum, Temples and colorful bazaars speak of the PINK CITY'S glorious regal past.}

Day 02: Jaipur

After breakfast leave for a Sight Seeing tour around Jaipur. The first attraction which you visit today is the **Amber Fort & Palace**. Explore the glorious past of Rajasthan with a visit to these historical attractions. Later, take a photo stop at **Jal Mahal**, Later visit **Albet Hall Museum**. In the evening, visit the famous **Laxmi Narayan Mandir**. Later enjoy at Shopping mall **OR Pink City Bazar** **OR** you can take an **optional tour** to visit **Chokhi Dhani – An Ethnic Village Resort**. Late night return back to hotel. **Over Night stay at Jaipur Hotel.**

Day 03: Jaipur – Chittorgarh – Udaipur (450 Km / 7-8 hrs)

After breakfast check out from hotel and drive to Udaipur. Enroute visit Chittorgarh, Visit in **fort, Temple – Palace – garden – Kund – Vijay Stambh** etc. later continue drive to Udaipur (3Hrs). Evening arrive Udaipur, Hotel check in. **Over Night stay at Udaipur Hotel.**

{Chittorgarh is the epitome of Rajput pride, romance and spirit. It reverberates with history of heroism and sacrifice, which is evident as it echoes with the tales sung by the Bards of Rajasthan. The main reason for visiting Chittorgarh is its massive hilltop fort, which is a depiction of Rajput culture and values. The fort stands on a 240-hectares site on a 180m high hill that rises rapidly from the plains below.}

Day 04: Udaipur Sight Seeing

After breakfast start for Udaipur city tour Visit **City Palace** – The largest palace complex of Rajasthan, **Jagdish Temple** – built by Maharana Jagat Singh and is dedicated to Lord Vishnu, **Rope Way & Later visit Seheliyon-KI-Bari** - Queen's resort for their friends, **Maharana Pratap Memorial, Fateh Sagar** (Enjoy Boating & take a photo stop at **Nehru Garden) Sukhadia Circle (Drive Pass)**, **Over Night stay at Udaipur Hotel.**

{Udaipur Known as the "City of Lakes" & "Venice of the East" formerly the capital of the Mewar Kingdom, is the crown jewel of the state of Rajasthan. Udaipur is surrounded by the lush green Aravali Hills & series of four water lakes. It's founded by Maharaja Udai Singh II in 1552. The Palaces, grand Gardens, Lakes, Museums and cultural shows present a glimpse of its rich past.}

Day 05: Udaipur – Kumbhalgarh via Haldhi Ghati Museum (90 Km / 2 hrs)

After breakfast check out from hotel and drive for Kumbhalgarh. Enroute visit Haldhi Ghati Museum. After Noon arrive Kumbhalgarh, Hotel check in, later visit **Kumbhalgarh fort** along with world's 2nd largest Wall, **Temple, Palace** etc. In Evening enjoy **Light & Sound Show**. **Over Night stay at Kumbhalgarh Hotel.**

{The Kumbhalgarh fort built in the 15th century AD by Rana Kumbha, it's the second most important fort of Rajasthan and is a truly magnificent sight. The charming location of the fort at the foothills of pebbly

Aravalli hills increases the overall appeal of the place. The wall of Kumbhalgarh Fort is the second longest continuous wall in the world, after the Great Wall of China, The wall of the fort stretches some 36 km and is situated at a height of 1,914 m. The 586 sq km. Kumbhalgarh Wildlife Sanctuaries has a jungle Safari to offer too, a rich variety of wildlife like the panther, sloth bear, wild boar, four-horned antelope and so many wild animals}

Day 06: Kumbhalgarh – Jodhpur via Ranakpur (200 Km / 5 hrs)

Morning, after breakfast Hotel check out & drive to Mt. Abu, Enroute visit [Ranakpur Jain](#) built in 1439. This marble temple has 29 halls supported by 1444 pillars. On Arrival Jodhpur, visit local city tour covering [Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum](#), and [Mandore Garden](#) etc, later check-in to your hotel. **Over Night** stay at **Jodhpur Hotel**.

{Jodhpur, formerly known as Marwar it's also known as the "The Blue City", "Sun City "and "Gateway to Thar". The city was founded in 1459 A.D by the Rathore rulers. Jodhpur is famous for its Mehrangarh fort, Palace, Temples, Sweets – Snacks and Blue Houses, as most of the architecture – forts, palaces, temples, havelis and even houses are built in vivid shades of blue in the old cit.}

Day 07: Jodhpur – Jodhpur Airport / Railway Station

After breakfast check out from hotel & visit [Mehrangarh Fort](#)- situated on a low sandstone hill, with in the fort visit Moti Mahal and Phool Mahal. Also visit [Jaswant Thada](#) - an imposing marble cenotaph built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II around 1899 etc. later transfer to Jodhpur / Jaipur (5-6Hrs) Railway Station / Airport for your onward / return Journey. **"Tour End With Sweet Memories of a Wonderful Holiday."**
