

JAIPUR (2N) – {CHITTAURGARH} – UDAIPUR (2N) – JODHPUR (1N) – JAISALMER (2N)

Day 01: Arrive in Jaipur

Arrival at Jaipur Railway Station / Airport, transfer to hotel. Check-in to the hotel and freshen up. Later leave for half day local Sight-seeing around the city. You can begin with a visit to the [City Palace](#) which is known to be the formal residence of a royal family, visit Chandra mahal – City Palace Museum which houses the private collection of Jaipur Maharajas, After Sight Seeing around the palace, visit [Jantar-Mantar](#) which is a stone observatory and the largest observatory built by Maharaja Jai Singh, also visit [Hawa Mahal](#) & In the evening enjoy Shopping in [Colorful Pink City Bazar](#). **Over Night stay at Jaipur Hotel.**

*{Jaipur : The capital city of Rajasthan, is a vibrant combination of the old and the new. It was developed as a planned city in the 1727 AD by Sawai Jai Singh II. Beautiful Palaces, Forts, Museum, Temples and colorful bazaars speak of the **PINK CITY'S** glorious regal past.}*

Day 02: Jaipur

After breakfast leave for a Sight Seeing tour around Jaipur. The first attraction which you visit today is the [Amber Fort & Palace](#). Explore the glorious past of Rajasthan with a visit to these historical attractions. Later, take a photo stop at [Jal-Mahal](#), Later visit [Albert Hall Museum](#). In the evening, visit the famous [Laxmi Narayan Mandir](#). Later enjoy at Shopping mall **OR** Pink City Bazar **OR** you can take an **optional tour** to visit [Chokhi Dhani – An Ethnic Village Resort](#). Late night return back to hotel. **Over Night stay at Jaipur Hotel.**

Day 03: Jaipur – Udaipur (450 Km / 7-8 hrs) Via Chittorgarh Fort Or Nathdwara Temple

After breakfast check out from hotel and drive to Udaipur. Enroute visit Chittorgarh, Visit in [fort, Temple – Palace – garden – Kund – Vijay Stambh](#) **OR** [Via Nathdwara – Ikiling Ji Temple \(Go via any 1 Way\)](#) etc. later continue drive to Udaipur (3Hrs). Evening arrive Udaipur, Hotel check in. **Over Night stay at Udaipur Hotel.**

NOTE: 2 ways going to Udaipur, Via [Chittorgarh Fort](#) **OR** [Nathdwara temple](#), you can enroute visit any 1 point

NOTE FOR NATHDWARA TEMPLE : The Darshan timing frequently changing, so before visiting the temple check it's website(www.nathdwaratemple.org) for that day timing & reach at least half an hour before the set time

{Chittorgarh is the epitome of Rajput pride, romance and spirit. It reverberates with history of heroism and sacrifice, which is evident as it echoes with the tales sung by the Bards of Rajasthan. The main reason for visiting Chittorgarh is its massive hilltop fort, which is a depiction of Rajput culture and values. The fort stands on a 240-hectares site on a 180m high hill that rises rapidly from the plains below}.

Day 04: Udaipur Sight Seeing

After breakfast start for Udaipur city tour Visit [City Palace](#) – The largest palace complex of Rajasthan, [Jagdish Temple](#) – built by Maharana Jagat Singh and is dedicated to Lord Vishnu, [Rope Way](#) & Later visit [Seheliyon-KI-Bari](#) - Queen's resort for their friends, [Maharana Pratap Memorial](#), [Fateh Sagar](#) (Enjoy Boating & take a photo stop at [Nehru Garden](#)) [Sukhadia Circle \(Drive Pass\)](#), **Over Night stay at Udaipur Hotel.**

{Udaipur Known as the "City of Lakes" & "Venice of the East" formerly the capital of the Mewar Kingdom, is the crown jewel of the state of Rajasthan. Udaipur is surrounded by the lush green Aravali Hills & series of four water lakes. It's founded by Maharaja Udai Singh II in 1552. The Palaces, grand Gardens, Lakes, Museums and cultural shows present a glimpse of its rich past.}

Day 05: Udaipur to Jodhpur (270 Km / 4-5 hrs) Via Rankpur Jain temple Or Nathdwara Temple

After breakfast transfer to Jodhpur. Enroute visit [Ikling ji & Nathdwara Temple](#) built in 1439 OR Via [Rankpur Jain Temple](#) (Visiting Time between 12 Noon – 5pm) (Go via any 1 Way) On arrival check-in to your hotel. In Evening visit [Mandore Garden & local market](#) for shopping etc. **Over Night** stay at **Jodhpur Hotel**.

NOTE: 2 ways going to Jodhpur, Via [Rankpur Jain Temple](#) OR [Nathwdara Temple](#). Enroute you can visit any 1 point

NOTE FOR NATHDWARA TEMPLE : The Darshan timing frequently changing, so before visiting the temple check it's website(www.nathdwaratemple.org) for that day timing & reach at least half an hour before the set time

{Jodhpur, formerly known as Marwar, it's also known as the "The Blue City", "Sun City "and "Gateway to Thar". The city was founded in 1459 A.D by the Rathore rulers. Jodhpur is famous for its Mehrangarh fort, Palace, Temples, Sweets – Snacks and Blue Houses, as most of the architecture – forts, palaces, temples, havelis and even houses are built in vivid shades of blue in the old cit.}

Day 06: Jodhpur – Jaisalmer via Ramdevra Temple (260 Km / 4-5 hrs)

Morning after B/fast, hotel check out on time & Start for a full day city tour i.e. [Mehrangarh fort](#), [Umaid Bhawan Palace](#), [Jaswant Thada](#) etc. later to Jaisalmer. Enroute visit [Ramdevra Temple](#). Arrive Jaisalmer, visit [War Museum & Gadisar Lake](#), Later Hotel check in. In evening visit local Market for shopping etc. **Over Night** stay at **Jaisalmer Hotel**.

{Jaisalmer, "the Golden City", is known for its Fort Rajwada, yellow sandstone Structures, dusky Landscape , romantic Sand Dunes, ravishing Havelis, splendid Temples, graceful with Lakes and vibrant Bazaars. The city was founded in 12th century by Ruler Rawla Jaisal.}

Day 07: Jaisalmer Sight Seeing & Camp

After breakfast, Hotel check out visit the [Jaisalmer Fort](#) which is made by unique Golden Lime stone, that's why it's known as Golden Fort or Sonar Qila. After that, visit [Jain Temple](#), [Patwon-ki-haveli](#), [Nathmal-ki-haveli](#).[Salim Singh-ki-Haveli](#). People still live in these ancient buildings dating from 12th to 15th century. Every house has exquisite carvings and filigreed work. After that drive to Sum Desert (40Km /1Hr), Arrive [Desert Camp city](#), check in your Dlx Swiss tent, later enjoy camel ride on Sam Sand Dunes & you can experience the spectacular view of Sunset in Thar desert & later enjoy Folk dance Program with Traditional Dinner. **Over Night** stay at **Jaisalmer Camp**.

Day 08: Jaisalmer – Jodhpur Station / Airport

After breakfast checkout from Desert Camp and transfer to Jaisalmer city, Enroute explore [Lodurva](#), [Kuldhara](#), [Amar Sagar & Bada bagh](#). Later drop at Jaisalmer Railway Station / Airport Or Jodhpur (5-6Hrs) for your onward / return Journey. **"Tour End with Sweet Memories of a Wonderful Holiday."**
